 Reasons: Questions about housing affordability & project feasibility. Interest in reducing funding request.



#### Revitalize the Town Hall with a State of the Art Opera House & Exterior Improvements

- Location: 21 Central Avenue
- Sponsor: Town of Lancaster & Lancaster Opera House
- Total Cost: \$1,281,000
- Request: \$1,156,000
- % of Total Cost: 95%
- Description: New signage and windows, lighting & sound equipment upgrades
- LPC Meeting #5 Draft Decision: Tabled
  - Reasons: Interest in expanding Opera House components and increasing match.



## **Energize Lancaster with a Mobility Hub on Central Avenue**

Location: 21 Central Avenue

• Sponsor: Town of Lancaster & Lancaster Opera House

• Total Cost: \$413,000

• Request: \$413,000

• % of Total Cost: 100%

 Description: EV charging stations, bike storage, covered bus stop, landscaping

• LPC Meeting #5 Draft Decision: Tabled

Reasons: Interest in increasing Village match.

#### **Next Steps**

- Electronic ballots will be circulated to the LPC
- Notices will be provided to all project sponsors
- Draft SIP will be submitted to the State
- State will select \$4.5 million in projects to award
- State will make award announcements in late 2023/early 2024
- Projects will be assigned a State agency based on scope who will reach out regarding the award and contracting
- Projects can begin incurring costs the first day of the month following the award announcement
- Project sponsors will provide updates and deliverables as specified in their grant contracts
- State agencies will be in contact regularly to provide support and monitor progress
- Press events may be held in connection with ground-breakings and ribbon-cuttings
